

The American mindset regarding raising children in the 21st century has drastically changed from that of the previous generation of baby boomers. As a result, much of the United States is seeing a gradual rise in median age and a general slowing of new children being born. From 2000 to 2010, Hamilton County's aging patterns reflected the nation's, as the median age for the county has increased about 5% since 2000. Only seven jurisdictions had a lower median age in 2010 than in 2000: Cheviot, Columbia Township, Golf Manor, Lockland, Mariemont, Norwood, and Springdale.

Although most of the county is fairly sporadic in median age, it is apparent in both the 2000 and 2010 Median Age by Jurisdiction maps (pg. 44) that an older population resides in the northeast corner of the county. Located in that vicinity, Amberley Village, Evendale, Glendale, Indian Hill, Madeira, Montgomery, Silverton, and Sycamore Township all have a median age of over 42.6 years of age. Crosby Township and North Bend are the only other two jurisdictions in the county with comparable aging populations.

Of the jurisdictions with the lowest median ages, Addyston, Cincinnati, Cleves, Columbia Township, Harrison, and Lincoln Heights all fall within the 32 to 35 years of age category.






## 2000 Median Age by Jurisdiction



As previously mentioned, the children of the baby boomers in Hamilton County are not repopulating as quickly as their parents did. Of the forty-nine jurisdictions in Hamilton County, only nineteen had a positive increase in children under 5 years of age. Of those, Cleves, Harrison, and North Bend were among the highest with over a 25% increase in the past decade. Harrison also had the largest numerical increase in the county.

Of the many municipalities to decrease their population under the age of 5, Addyston, Arlington Heights, Elmwood Place, Evendale, Harrison Township, Silverton, the Village of Indian Hill, and Whitewater Township were hit the hardest, all losing over 20% of this young demographic. Cincinnati lost the largest numerical number, reaching over 2,000. Overall, the under 5 years of age population decreased around 5.8% (roughly 3,200 people) in Hamilton County from 2000-2010.




**Percent of 2010 Population Under 5 Years of Age by Jurisdiction**



Making up nearly a quarter of the county's residents, the population under 18 years of age is the second largest demographic group in the county. Similar to the population under 5 years of age, however, the population under 18 years of age also declined over the past decade. Totaling just over a 28,500 resident loss, the underage population is down 13% from 2000. Although Colerain Township, Delhi Township, Harrison, Norwood, and Springfield Township all contributed over a 1,000 person decline to this data, the City of Cincinnati accounted for over half of the total loss in this age demographic at over 15,000.

There were only six jurisdictions that increased their child population over the past decade: Amberley Village, Cleves, Harrison, Mariemont, Northbend, and Springdale.


**Percent of 2000 Population Under 18 Years of Age by Jurisdiction**

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

The largest age demographic in Hamilton County consists of the “working population,” or those who are between the ages of 18 to 64 years of age. Spanning 46 years, this demographic declined the least amount of all the age demographics at about 2% for the county, which equates to over 7,000 residents.

Whereas in 2000 this age group lived sporadically within the county, 2010 appears to show a pattern centered around the City of Cincinnati. Currently the most concentrated jurisdictions include Arlington Heights, Deer Park, Lockland, Norwood, Silverton, and Woodlawn with over 65% of their populations being made up of this age group.




**Percent of 2010 Working Population: 18-64 Years of Age by Jurisdiction**








**Percent of 2000 Working Population: 18-64 Years of Age by Jurisdiction**








**Percent Change 2000-2010 in Working Population (18-64 Years of Age) by Jurisdiction**

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

One of two age groups classified as “elderly,” the population over 65 years of age is sometimes also referred to as “retirement aged population.” It is the third largest age group in Hamilton County, making up about 13% of the total population.

From 2000 to 2010, this population declined like all the previously mentioned age groups. Nearly all of the jurisdictions to follow this trend were around or just north of Cincinnati. On the other hand, the most heavily populated municipalities of this group were Amberley Village, Glendale, North Bend, and Springdale.




**Percent of 2010 Elderly Population: 65 Years of Age and Older by Jurisdiction**






**Percent of 2000 Population Over 65 Years of Age by Jurisdiction**

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

In 2010, the only age group to increase in population size was the elderly population over 85 years of age. From 2000 to 2010, the elderly population over 85 years of age grew over 8% at about 1,200 people.

Similar to 2000 data, this age demographic is generally concentrated in the northeastern quarter of the county. Deer Park, Montgomery, Mount Healthy, Sharonville, Springdale, and Sycamore Township are the most densely populated with this age group, all between 3.6% to 4.7%. Of the seventeen jurisdictions to lose numbers in this age group, Cincinnati lost the most at over 1,100 residents, while Green Township gained the most at over 600 residents.




