# foreword


Hamilton County, Ohio was formally established as the second county in the Northwest Territory on January 2, 1790. With its prime location bordering Indiana and Kentucky along the Ohio River, Hamilton County (illustrated to the right in yellow) has served as a vital hub for regional commerce since its inception.

The City of Cincinnati, the largest municipality in the county, once attracted a melting pot of settlers, German and Irish immigrants, and freed African American slaves to reside within its boundaries. Abundant with jobs in meat packing, steamboat construction/repair, and hospitality, Cincinnati was the most densely populated city in the United States by the turn of the twentieth century with an average of 37,143 persons per square mile.

As the industrial revolution changed Cincinnati's job market and allowed residents to move further from the urban core, growth began to expand outward into the more topographically challenging areas of Hamilton County. Neighborhoods surrounding Cincinnati like Norwood, Elmwood Place, and St. Bernard (commonly referred to as "first suburbs") experienced a rapid, dense growth period during the early 1900s.

Funded by the National Defense Highway Act of 1956, the construction of the I-71, I-75, and I-275 highways fueled another wave of outward expansion from the city core, known as "second-ring suburbs." In areas like Anderson Township, Green Township, and Harrison, lot sizes are larger and less dense than the previous status quo. More than ever, rural areas are being converted from farmland or natural environments to residential and commercial developments. Similarly, technology has allowed for humans to reside in the county's seemingly unlivable geographies, namely its steep hillsides.

Now with a population of 802,374, approximately 1,970 people per square mile call Hamilton County home. This document illustrates how the demographics of the county has developed by jurisdiction from as early as 1970 to present. It is the goal of this analysis to communicate the changes that Hamilton County has experienced in its population size, demographic, and housing types.


Hamilton County has experienced a significant fluctuation of growth over the past forty years, with a loss of over 121,000 residents. Some communities have struggled with development, while others have seemingly popped up from no where. For example, the urban core of the county, Cincinnati, has lost almost half of its population since 1970, yet many outlying rural and suburban areas have nearly doubled their population in that same time.

In the same fashion as the rest of the nation, residents of Hamilton County have shown that they have preferred lower density, suburban communities over the past forty years. Many of the municipalities that experienced 50% growth or more since 1970 reside on the outskirts of the county: Anderson Township, Cleves, Crosby Township, Harrison, Harrison Township, Loveland, Miami Township, Montgomery, Symmes Township, and Whitewater Township.

Most of the municipalities that have lost at least 25% of their population have dense suburban settings. Most of these declining communities border the City of Cincinnati, including: Arlington Heights, Columbia Township, Elmwood Place, Fairfax, Golf Manor, Norwood, St. Bernard, and Silverton.

Overall, Hamilton County has lost over 120,000 people since 1970--a tenth of its former population.


# HAMILTON COUNTY 2010 CENSUS DATA



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


**Numerical Change 2000-2010 in Total Population by Jurisdiction**








**Percent Change 2000-2010 in Total Population by Jurisdiction**



Similar to total population, Hamilton County has also experienced some major changes in population density, or persons per square mile, since 1970. Whereas Cincinnati used to be the most densely populated municipality in the county, now it is no longer. Currently, municipalities bordering the urban core like Cheviot, Deer Park, Elmwood Place, Gold Manor, North College Hill, and Norwood lead the county in density, each with over 5,000 persons per square mile.

As the Percent Change in Density Map, (pages 6 and 13) demonstrates, many of the outlying jurisdictions in the county experienced a significant increase in density. Municipalities that border the edge of the county like Harrison, Harrison Township, Miami Township, and Symmes Township experienced the highest increase in density. This can be attributed to the fact that these areas were previously sparsely populated, and the development that occurred had a more profound impact, simply because there was so much land to be consumed for residential uses.




## Population Density 1970







After examining how the population has grown over time, it is useful to understand what areas of the county hold what portions of the county population. Moreover, it is important to study how the proportional distribution of the population has shifted among the jurisdictions to understand how the county population has changed as a whole. This data is crucial in identifying growth patterns, developing smart growth strategy plans, and determining areas for redevelopment in accordance with housing market trends.

Once again, data suggests that the largest percent change in growth occurred in the suburban jurisdictions on the outer lying areas of the county. In 1970, the City of Cincinnati held nearly half of the county's population, while today it holds only 37%. Contrarily, county residents showed their fondness for low-density development as townships on the fringe of the county like Anderson, Crosby, Harrison, Miami, and Symmes each grew at least 80% since 1970. Consequently, now Anderson, Colerain, and Green Townships hold at least 5% of the county population each.

Paired with data of jurisdictions that lost proportional population, this data points to an increase in development in the jurisdictions on the fringe of the county. Many areas directly surrounding the I-75 and I-71 corridors lost population. Those most dramatically hit by the decline (-25% - -50%) surround the urban core, including Arlington Heights, Columbia Township, Elmwood Place, Fairfax, Golf Manor, Norwood, St. Bernard, Silverton, and more. Other jurisdictions just north of these areas, such as Amberley Village, Deer Park, Glendale, Mount Healthy, North College Hill, Springfield Township, and Wyoming, experienced up to -25% decline.




**Proportional Distribution of 2010 County Population by Jurisdiction**
