Pursuant to O.R.C. §3115.601 et seq., notice is hereby given to the Defendant that a Registration of a Foreign Support Order has been filed by the Plaintiff in the Office of the Clerk of Courts, Court of Common Pleas, Hamilton County, Ohio. Attached are copies of all documents filed in this action in support of Plaintiff's request to register a foreign support order.

A registered order that is confirmed pursuant to §3115.602 of the Ohio Revised Code is enforceable as of the date of registration in the same manner as an order issued by a tribunal of this state.

A hearing to contest the validity or enforcement of the registered order must be requested pursuant to §3115.606 of the Ohio Revised Code no later than **twenty days** after the date of mailing or personal service of this notice. **The failure to contest the validity or enforcement of the registered order in a timely manner will result in confirmation of the order and enforcement of the order and the alleged arrearages, and precludes further contest of the order with respect to any matter that could have been asserted.**

Plaintiff alleges that there is an arrearage of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ due and owing on the child support order to be registered in this Court.

Upon registration of the foreign support order for enforcement, a withholding order notice shall be sent to defendant's employer pursuant to §3121 of the Ohio Revised Code.
